

RETRIEVING CHRI

USER GUIDE

For customers retrieving Criminal History Record Information (CHRI) directly through our platform, the FBI requires that the customer acknowledges receipt of the results before the results are made available in a report.


The FBI requires Fieldprint to purge CHRI in the event that they are not retrieved and saved within 30 days of the results being received.

Once the results are retrieved and stored within Truescreen, we will archive those records according to our retention policy.

This guide will walk users through the steps required to retrieve CHRI results.


RETRIEVING SINGLE RESULTS

Once results are returned, you can receive CHRI results by clicking the "Retrieve and Save CHRI" hyperlink under the Additional Request section of the right column.






On the Get CHRI Results page, click the "Retrieve" button in the CHRI Results grid to retrieve the CHRI results for the subject.



After retrieving CHRI results, you will then be able to view the results directly on the subject's case summary page under the Additional Request section on the right.






There will also be a hyperlink to the Criminal History Record Information within the subject's report in the Fingerprinting section. This link will not appear until CHRI is retrieved and saved.

BULK RETRIEVE CHRI

CHRI can be retrieved in bulk by selecting the "CHRI" button on the Screening Reports grid.



On the Get CHRI Results page, click the "Retrieve" button in the CHRI Results grid to retrieve the CHRI results for all subjects in the grid.




You will then be able to view the CHRI for all subjects in the grid when on their respective case summary pages.



READING THE CHRI RESULT STATUS

It is important to note that neither Truescreen nor Fieldprint have access to actual CHRI results – only the authorized recipient may view CHRI. **As a result, it is not possible for Truescreen to "score" CHRI results as "pass" or "review"**.

The initial component status of returned CHRI results is "Results Received". Clients will see this result after the results are returned from the FBI. "Results Received" is not an indication that CHRI results have been retrieved and saved.



Within the report itself, the status will display "Clear". It is important to note that a "Clear" result for FBI fingerprints within a report does not indicate that there are no records found. Users are required to review the CHRI returned from the FBI and adjudicate the results accordingly. Note in the screenshot below that there is no link to CHRI results, since the results in this example have not been retrieved and saved.





When CHRI results are saved and retrieved properly, the report will show "See Below". This indicates that the Criminal History Record Information is available to review.
